

## English

**Coverage** - Recount, instructions, character description, weather script report, weather description, diary entry, informal letter, narrative, poetry, information text.

**Texts:** Cloudy with a chance of meatballs, Dangerous weather (nonfiction), Cloudy with the chance of meatballs - weird weather.

**Animations** - A cloudy lesson, For the birds, Catch-a-lot, coming home, Moz (Christmas advert).

**Music** - Snoopy the musical

**Language Skills** - Individual Speech and Language programmes

**Word level** - focus on understanding words and using them appropriately, including using a dictionary.

**Sentence level** - writing and punctuating sentences correctly.

**Guided Reading** - focused sessions in small groups to read, discuss and carry out comprehension tasks.

**Individual Reading** - pupils will be heard individually in class and will receive a book to read at home.

**Reading for Meaning** - Listen and discuss chosen text as a class.

**Handwriting** - weekly sessions tailored to the needs of individual pupils - focus on letter formation.

**Spelling** - weekly spellings to practise at home.

## Mathematics

**Number and Place Value** - counting on, reading and writing numbers, recognise the value of each digit, compare and order numbers, counting in 1's, 2's, 10's, 100's

**Addition and Subtraction** - Addition and subtraction facts, mental addition and subtraction, addition and subtraction problems, addition and subtraction in columns

**Multiplication** - arrays, 2, 3, 4, 5, 8, 10 multiplication facts.

**Measure** - comparing and measuring length (cm and mm). Calculating and making different amounts of money. Recognising notes and coins.

**Properties of Shape** - properties of 2-D shapes, patterns, angles, line of symmetry.

## Geography

**Focus** - Different types of weather

**Extreme weather** - Tornadoes, volcanoes, earthquakes, tsunamis.

Different places experience different weather/ climate.

Maps, globe, atlases.
