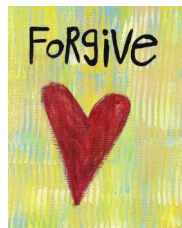

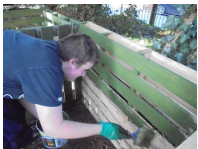

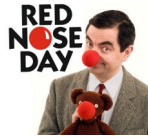
Please come and visit to see how much has already been achieved. Well behaved dogs on leads are welcome in the outside seating area.
